The MDHA Conservation Tree Program is up and running for 2026!

This program is provided to help you, our members, get trees at a discounted rate for planting on your properties to benefit whitetail deer and your hunting this fall.

New this year is the addition of a limited number of pear trees to be given on a first order, first given basis.

Trees are \$35 per tree for 2026. Trees are 5'-8' bareroot stock. All varieties are hardy for all Minnesota planting zones.

Pickup will be at locations in Coon Rapids, Grand Rapids and Wadena. We will notify you of the pickup date. There will be NO REFUNDS on orders that are not picked up.

Trees are not guaranteed. Proper care from pickup to planting and watering is vitally important to survival. It is your responsibility to take proper care of your trees. MDHA will provide handouts on how to care for your tree as well as have them available on the MDHA website.
